Kirkby Thore Primary School - Primary PE & Sports Grant 2013-2014

Our total PE & Sports grant for the 2013/14 academic year was £8460. Of that we have so far spent £4560 with the balance being spent in the coming summer term.

Throughout the past year, we have spent our sports grant on several projects to improve the quality and breadth of PE and sport provision within our school. We joined Eden Valley Sports Partnership which has enabled us to participate in sporting events and competitions and have welcomed coaches into school to work with the children in all year groups on a range of different sports.

The remainder of the funding will be spent on

- maintaining our existing facilities in the grounds
- improving the equipment and resources the children use during breaks
- introducing the children to volley ball, tennis and badminton
- line marking pitches outside for tennis and in the school hall for indoor tennis, volley ball and badminton
- maintaining good quality PE equipment

Over the next year, we will:

- Work within our small cluster of schools to organise sporting events and competitions
- Use some of the money to pay for transport to a range of local sports events
- Train our Year 6 children to become Young Leaders
- Provide swimming coaches for our Year 3-6 children
- Introduce the children to a range of new activities in order to increase their confidence to try new activities in a different environment
- Work towards renewing the large climbing apparatus in the school grounds
